The mission of the Society is to advance the knowledge of nutrition and metabolism in kidney diseases and renal transplantation, and to foster communication of the advancements of this knowledge through scientific meetings and cooperation/collaborations with other scientific societies of nephrology, nutrition, dieticians, biochemistry and physiology. The aim of ISRNM is to raise greater awareness and recognition of the importance of renal nutrition and metabolism in kidney diseases.

On behalf of the ISRNM Executive Committee, we invite interested ISRNM members and Associate members to submit an Expression of Interest if you wish to be considered for election to the ISRNM Council. If you are currently non-members, but if you have interest with renal nutrition and metabolism and exercises, you can join membership of ISRNM and are eligible for the nomination.

In April, 2020, two Councilor and one Associate Councilor positions will be open on the 2020-2022 ISRNM Council. General Councilor positions are open to Physician/Scientist ISRNM members; Associate Councilor positions are open to Associate ISRNM members. **On line voting starts March 1st, 2020, and will end March, 31st, 2020.**

Elected Council candidates will serve a 2-year term starting at the end of ICRNM 2020 in Guang-Zhou, China. Council positions may be renewable for a second 2-year term.

If you wish to nominate or self-nominate a Council candidate, please send an expression of interest to Elke Frohmüller (frohmuelle_e@ukw.de). Messages should include a brief CV (3 pages or less) and a brief description (no more than 1 page) of why you want to become an ISRNM Council/Associate Council member: **The application ends on Dec., 31st, 2019.**
